Driving Directions

From Toronto:

- * Take Highway 401 east to Highway 35/115
- * Follow Highway 115 north
- * At Peterborough, exit at The Parkway
- * Continue on The Parkway to Lansdowne Street
- * Turn right (east) on Lansdowne Street
- * Follow Lansdowne Street to George Street
- * Turn left (north) on George Street
- * Follow George Street as it turns right into Water Street at Sherbrooke Street when you reach downtown
- * Continue north on Water Street for approximately 7 km
- * Turn right on Nassau Mills Road
- * Turn left on West Bank Drive and proceed to the Bata Library

From Ottawa:

* Follow Highway 7 west (Lansdowne Street) to George Street

* Turn right (north) on George Street immediately following the Peterborough Memorial Centre

* Follow George Street as it turns right into Water Street at Sherbrooke Street when you reach downtown

- * Continue north on Water Street for approximately 7 km
- * Turn right on Nassau Mills Road
- * Turn left on West Bank Drive and proceed to the Bata Library

From Kingston:

- * Take Highway 401 west to Highway 28 North at Port Hope
- * Follow Highway 28 north to Highway 115 (just past Kawartha Downs racetrack)
- * Take Highway 115 east to Peterborough
- * At Peterborough, exit at The Parkway
- * Continue on The Parkway to Lansdowne Street
- * Turn right (east) on Lansdowne Street
- * Follow Lansdowne Street to George Street
- * Turn left (north) on George Street
- * Follow George Street as it turns right into Water Street at Sherbrooke Street when you reach downtown
- * Continue north on Water Street for approximately 7 km
- * Turn right on Nassau Mills Road
- * Turn left on West Bank Drive and proceed to the Bata Library

There is a visitor parking lot across from the library. To get to our meeting room, enter the library through the main entrance. Go past the circulation desk and go down the main

staircase to the lower level. Turn right past the information commons and through the double doors. We are meeting in the <u>Smith Conference Room (Room 107.2)</u>. Lunch will be just outside the room.

There is also GO service from Toronto Union Station. There is a train to Oshawa with a transfer to a bus to Peterborough. You only need a single ticket and the bus is waiting when the train arrives in Oshawa. On Saturday mornings, train departures are at 7:13 a.m. or 10:13 a.m. with the bus arriving on Trent campus at 9:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m., respectively. The bus stop is on the east bank of the campus so you will need to cross the bridge to get to the library.

Return buses leave campus at 6:10 p.m. and 10:10 p.m. (or the downtown bus terminal 15 minutes later.) There is also Sunday service for anyone who plans to stay overnight.
